



Parents and Athletes,

The following are rules and bylaws from the CIF-SS Blue Book as it relates to competition on an outside team during your specific season of sport:

ARTICLE 60

OUTSIDE COMPETITION

Bylaw-600.

- **COMPETITION ON AN OUTSIDE TEAM-** A student on a high school team becomes ineligible if the student competes in a contest on an “outside” team, in the same sport, during the student’s high school season of sport.

Rule 1510.

- **OUTSIDE COMPETITION BY AN INDIVIDUAL**
During An Individual’s Season of Sport - A member of a high school softball team may not, during his or her season of sport, compete for an outside team in the sport of softball. A season of sport is defined as that period which begins with student’s first interscholastic competition (non-league, tournament or league game) and ends with that student’s last interscholastic contest (non-league, tournament or CIF Southern Section playoff).

The season of sport for a school is that period of time which elapses between the first interscholastic contest and the final contest for that particular sport. The season of a sport for any individual student is that period of time which elapses between the student’s first participation in an interscholastic contest and the student’s final participation in a contest for that particular sport in that season.

Outside Teams include but are not limited to:

- Little League
- Pony League
- Recreational teams
- All travel/club teams

We have read and understand the above CIF-SS rules and bylaws as it relates to “Outside Competition by and Individual” and agree not to compete for an outside team in the sport of softball during this spring season.
