- _____ 1 unopened package of 100 sheets of loose-leaf wide-ruled paper.
- _____ 1 blue 2-pocket folder with "In Class Folder" and the child's name written on the front cover. No brads.
This folder always remains in the child's desk and is for work that we will continue the next day.
- _____ 1 red 2-pocket folder with "Homework Folder" and the child's name written on the front cover. No brads.
- _____ 1 yellow 2-pocket folder with "Rotation Classes" and the child's name written on the front cover. No brads. This folder stores papers given to them by their rotation teachers.
- _____ 1 Composition Note Book (**Garcia's and Galaviz's class only**)
- _____ 1 box of 24 colored pencils, pre-sharpened; Crayola brand preferred for language arts.
- _____ 2 large-tip whiteboard (dry-erase) markers in dark colors (ie: black, blue, green, maroon)
- _____ 1 small whiteboard eraser
- _____ 1 red ballpoint pen, 1 black ball pen.
- _____ 1 pair of small, sharp scissors
- _____ 2 glue sticks
- _____ 4 highlighters (2 different colors)
- _____ 1 protractor
- 1 ruler
- _____ 2 erasers that are not attached to a pencil
- _____ 2 mechanical pencils with attached erasers and one box of matching lead, OR 1 dozen pre-sharpened pencils.
- 1 personal pencil sharpener with a shavings catcher built in
- _____ 1 pair of earbuds or headphones
- _____ 3 spiral bound one-subject notebooks, wide ruled, with 70 sheets of paper. Needed for writing, math, small groups, and science
- 1 100 3x5 Index cards (Lined)
- 1 **OPTIONAL PERSONAL WHITEBOARD**
