Guidelines/Criteria

- Applicants must be seniors at a high school in Apple Valley
- Must plan on pursuing further education in health related fields, such as Pharmacy, Radiology, Dentistry, Nutrition, Nursing, Physical Therapy or Medicine
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Awards must be used to pay for tuition, books, school related fees, and/or room and board (receipts required)
- Awards will be sent to accredited institution

Application Form/Process

- Applicants must complete the required application and include the following:
 - An Official Academic Transcript
 - Applicant Consent Form
 - > Reference letter from a community organization, teacher or work supervisor
 - A 500 word essay about themselves and how receiving this scholarship and attending college will help them achieve their goals
 - Personal Interviews

Selection Process/Committee

Recipients are selected by the scholarship committee and members of the Kobold family.
